

# G0322/ JUMPER

EU dress size 36/38,40/42,44/46, US size 8/10, 12/14, 16/18



Instructions are given for each size. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

## MATERIALS

Gedifra Soffio

(37% alpaca, 37% wool, 26% silk; 187 m/25 g): 125/150/175 g in Light Blue color 610.

One pair size 4mm (UK 8/US 6) needles; cable needle [cn];

one size 3.5mm (UK 9/US E/4) crochet hook;

4 buttons

## 22-STITCH CENTER CABLE

Work according to chart. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows; on WS rows, work sts as they appear. Rep rows 1 - 23 throughout.

### **RIB PATTERN**

K1, p1.

# STOCKING STITCH

K on RS, p on WS.

## TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm/4in measured over st st with size 4mm needles or size needed to achieve tension.
PLEASE CHECK YOUR TENSION AS IT IS ESSENTIAL TO ACHIEVE THIS TENSION IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE SUCCESS.

## **BACK**

Cast on 98/106/114 sts.
Work in rib patt until piece meas 2cm/0.75in from cast-on, ending with RS facing for next row.
Work in st st until piece meas

Work in st st until piece meas 34/35/35.5cm [13.5/13.75/14]in from cast, ending with RS facing for next row. Shape armholes:

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 1 st at beg of next 4 rows. 86/94/102 sts.

Work even until armhole meas 20/21/22cm [7.75/8.25/8.75]in, ending with RS facing for next row. Shape neck and shoulders: Next row (RS): Cast off 7/9/10 sts, k20/24/26, turn and work this side first

leaving rem sts on hold.

Next row (WS): Cast off 3 sts, p to end.

Next row (RS): Cast off  $\frac{7}{9}$ 10 sts, k to end.

Next row (WS): Cast off 2 sts, k to end. Next row (RS): Cast off rem 8/10/11 sts. With RS facing, rejoin yarn.

Cast off center 30 sts, k to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

#### FRONT

Cast on 98/106/114 sts.

Work in rib patt until piece meas 2cm/0.75in from cast-on, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): Work st st over 38/42/46 sts, work center cable over 22 sts, work st st over 38/42/46 sts.

Cont in patt as established until piece meas 34/35/35.5cm [13.5/13.75/14] in from cast, ending with RS facing for next row. Shape armholes same as for back. 86/94/102 sts.

Work even until piece meas 52/54/55.5cm [20.5/21.25/21.75]in from cast-on, ending with RS facing for next

Shape neck:

K28/34/37, turn and work this side first leaving rem sts on hold.

Cast off 3 sts at neck edge once, 2 sts once, 1 st once.

At same time, when same length as back to shoulder, shape shoulder at right edge same as for back. With RS facing, rejoin yarn.

Cast off center 28 sts and at same time, drop sts on either side of cable crossings and unravel down to rib patt, k to end of row. Pull dropped sts to WS and secure.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Cast on 50/50/54 sts. Work in rib patt until piece meas 8cm/3.25in from caston, ending with RS facing for next row. Work in st st for 4 rows.

Shape sleeve:

Next inc row (RS): Inc 1 st at each end of row. 52/52/56 sts.

Rep inc row every 6th row 10 times more. 72/72/76 sts.

Work even until piece meas 50/50/52cm [19.75/19.75/20.5]in from cast-on, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape sleeve cap:

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 1 st at beg of next 24/24/26 rows. Loosely cast off rem 38/38/40 sts.

### **FINISHING**

Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams.

Collar:

Pick up and k 76/76/78 sts evenly along neck edge. Working back and forth in rows, work in rib patt until collar meas 15cm/6in from pick-up row. Loosely bind off all sts in rib. Using crochet hook, make four button loops evenly spaced along left edge of collar. Sew buttons to right edge of collar matching button loops.

Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.
