Long version: 18cm in circumference, 42cm long Short version: 14cm in circumference, 24cm long

MATERIALS FOR LONG VERSION Gedifra Dolce 85

(90% pure wool, 10% cashmere; 85m/50 g): 100 g in Light Blue Colour 00414

One pair size 4mm (UK 8/US 6) needles

MATERIALS FOR SHORT VERSION Gedifra Dolce 85

(90% pure wool, 10% cashmere; 85m/50 g): 100 g in Light Green Colour 00423 and small amount in Light Blue Colour 00414

One pair size 4mm (UK 8/US 6) needles

RIB PATTERN

On RS row, K1, * p2, k1; rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, k1; on WS row, work all sts as they appear.

TENSION

28 sts and 27 rows to 10cm/4in measured over rib patt on size 4mm needles or size needed to achieve tension.

PLEASE CHECK YOUR TENSION AS IT IS ESSENTIAL TO ACHIEVE THIS TENSION IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE SUCCESS.

LONG VERSION (make 2 alike) Using Light Blue cast on 52 sts. Next row (RS): K1, * p2, k1; rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, k1. Work in rib patt as established until piece meas 42cm from cast-on edge, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off all sts.

SHORT VERSION (make 2 alike)

Using Light Blue cast on 43 sts. Break Light Blue, change to Light Green. **Next row (RS)**: K1, * p2, k1; rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, k1. Work in rib patt as established until piece meas 24cm from cast-on edge, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off all sts.

FINISHING

Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew seams.

G0175 / VEST EU dress size 36/38, 40/42, 44/46. See size diagram for more details.

Instructions are given for each size. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

MATERIALS

Gedifra **Dolce 85** (90% pure wool, 10% cashmere; 85m/50 g): 400/450/500 g in Light Blue Color

00414 and 50g in Light Green Colour 00423

One pair 5mm (UK 6/US 8) needles One 4mm (UK 8/US 6) circular needle, 40cm/16in long One 70cm long zipper

STOCKING STITCH RS rows - K, WS rows - P.

2-COLOUR BRIOCHE STITCH Row 1 (RS), Light Green: SI 1 pwise

wyif, * p1, k1; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1. Row 2 (RS), Light Blue: SI 1 pwise wyif,

* p1, yfwd, sl 1 pwise; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Row 3 (WS), Light Green: SI 1 pwise wyif, * yfwd, sI 1 pwise, ptog next st and yfwd; rep from * to last 2 sts, yfwd, sI 1 pwise, k1.

Row 4 (WS), Light Blue: SI 1 pwise wyif, * ktog next st and yfwd, yfwd, sI 1 pwise; rep from * to last 2 sts, ktog next st and yfwd, k1.

Row 5, Light Green: SI 1 pwise wyif, * yfwd, sl 1 pwise, ktog next st and yfwd; rep from * to last 2 sts, yfwd, sl 1 pwise, k1.

Row 6, Light Blue: SI 1 pwise wyif, * ptog next st and yfwd, yfwd, sl 1 pwise; rep from * to last 2 sts, ptog next st and yfwd,



k1. Work rows 1 - 6 once, then rep rows 3 - 6 throughout.

5-STITCH SELVEDGE

<u>On RS row</u> - SI first 5 sts pwise wyib, pulling yarn tight, k last 5 sts. <u>On WS row</u> - SI first 5 sts pwise wyif, pulling yarn tight, p last 5 sts.

TENSION

18 sts and 23 rows to 10cm/4in measured over rib patt on 5mm needles or size needed to achieve tension. 14.5 sts and 38 rows to 10cm/4in measured over 2-colour brioche st on 4mm needles or size needed to achieve tension.

BACK

Using 5mm needles and Light Green cast on 71/81/91 sts.

Break Light Green, change to Light Blue. Next row (WS): K1, p1, * k2, p3; rep from

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Shape armholes

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows and 1 st at beg of next 4 rows. 55/65/75 sts. Cont straight until armhole meas 22.5/24.5/26.5cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulders and neck

Cast off 5/6/7 sts, work until there are 15/19/23 sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder. **Next row (WS):** Cast off 5 sts at neck edge, patt to end. 10/14/18 sts. **Next row:** Cast off 5/7/9 sts, patt to end.

Work 1 row. Cast off rem 5/7/9 sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn and cast off centre 15 sts, patt to end.

Next row (WS): Cast off 5/6/7 sts, patt to end.

Next row: Cast off 5 sts at neck edge, patt to end. 10/14/18 sts.

Next row: Cast off 5/7/9 sts, patt to end. Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 5/7/9 sts.

LEFT FRONT

Using 5mm needles and Light Green cast on 39/44/49 sts.

Break Light Green, change to Light Blue. **Next row (WS)**: Work 5-st selvedge as set above, * k2, p3; rep from * 5/6/7 times more, k2, p1, k1.

Next row: P1, k1, p2, * k3, p2, rep from * 5/6/7 times more, work 5 st selvedge as set above.

These 2 rows set patt.

Work in patt as established until piece meas 31cm from cast-on edge, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armhole

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next RS row, 2 sts at beg of next RS row and 1 st at beg of next 2 RS rows. 31/36/41 sts. Cont straight until armhole meas 18/20/22cm, ending with **WS** facing for next row

Shape front neck and shoulder Next row (WS): Cast off 8 sts at neck edge, patt to end. 23/28/33 sts. Work 1 row. Next row: Cast off 3 sts, patt to end. 20/25/30 sts. Work 1 row. Next row: Cast off 2 sts, patt to end. 18/23/28 sts. Work 1 row. Next row: Cast off 1 st, patt to end. 17/22/27 sts. Work 1 row. Rep last 2 rows once more. 16/21/26 sts. (Piece should now match Back to start of shoulder shaping) Next row: Cast off 5/6/7 sts at shoulder edge, patt to end. 11/15/19 sts. Next row: Cast off 1 st at neck edge, patt to end. 10/14/18 sts. Next row: Cast off 5/7/9 sts, patt to end. 5/7/9 sts. Work 1 row. Cast off rem 5/7/9 sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 5mm needles and Light Green cast on 39/44/49 sts.

Break Light Green, change to Light Blue. **Next row (WS)**: K1, p1, k2, * p3, k2, rep from * 5/6/7 times more, work 5-st selvedge as set above.

Next row: Work 5-st selvedge as set above, * p2, k3; rep from * 5/6/7 times more, p2, k1, p1.

Work in patt as established until piece meas 31cm from cast-on, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Shape armhole

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next **WS** row, 2 sts at beg of next **WS** row and 1 st at beg of next 2 **WS** rows. 31/36/41 sts.

Cont straight until armhole meas 18/20/22cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape front neck and shoulder

Next row (RS): Cast off 8 sts at neck edge, patt to end. 23/28/33 sts. Work 1 row.

Next row: Cast off 3 sts, patt to end. 20/25/30 sts.

Work 1 row.

Next row: Cast off 2 sts, patt to end. 18/23/28 sts.

Work 1 row.

Next row: Cast off 1 st, patt to end. 17/22/27 sts.

Work 1 row. Rep last 2 rows once more. 16/21/26 sts. (Piece should now match Back to start of shoulder shaping)

Next row: Cast off 5/6/7 sts at shoulder edge, patt to end. 11/15/19 sts.

Next row: Cast off 1 st at neck edge, patt

to end. 10/14/18 sts. **Next row:** Cast off 5/7/9 sts, patt to end. 5/7/9 sts. Work 1 row. Cast off rem 5/7/9 sts.

GUSSET (Make 2)

Using 5mm needles and Light Green cast on 31 sts. Beg with a WS row, work in st st until piece measures 31cm from cast-on edge. Cast off all sts.

FINISHING

Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Sew gussets to side edges of back.

Collar

Using 4mm circular needle and Light Green, pick up and knit 77 sts along right front, back and left front neck edge. Work in 2-col brioche st as set above until collar meas 19.5cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Using Light Green, cast off all sts kwise.

Armhole edgings

Using size 4mm circular needle and Light Green, pick up and knit 83/89/95 sts along left armhole.

Work in 2-col brioche st as set above for 2cm, ending with RS facing for next row. Using Light Green, cast off all sts kwise.

Sew side seams. Sew in zipper.
